Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office, Greg Palmer:

- Transition with new administration January 8th
- Finished year-long suicide mitigation project in the detention facility; frees up 48 beds which are needed
- JAC leaving will give a little more admin space, but not much in the way of inmate housing

Criminal Justice Planning Coordinators, Todd Spanier & Kally Enright:

- Summit for juvenile justice; working on implementing predictive analytics to try to help parents/schools to identify at-risk youth
- Helping the 18th with their Bridges Program
- Assisting Colorado Association of Community Corrections Boards with their quarterly meeting

District Attorney's Office, George Brauchler:

- Conviction Review Unit: geared toward people in prison to reach out regarding claims of innocence. To be made up of volunteers: retired Judges, Prosecutors, Defense Attorneys. The website will go live with forms, etc. Starting with felony convictions and people who are currently in the system.
- 2017 statute regarding marijuana convictions being sealed; who is eligible? Taking a hard look at the language and encouraging the legislature to rework it.
- Starting process of reviewing convictions/cases to develop "origin of offender" mapping
