Motor vehicle and driver's license offices to close on June 24 Election Day *Four Clerk and Recorder branches to serve as Voter Service and Polling Centers*

LITTLETON, CO – The Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder's Office will not offer driver's license or motor vehicle services on June 24, Primary Election Day. Recording services and marriage or civil union licenses will be available only at the County Administration Building in Littleton, 7 a.m.-5 p.m.

Four Motor Vehicle branch offices in Aurora, Byers, Centennial and Littleton are designated as Voter Service and Polling Centers and will be open only for election-related services 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., June 24. The Altura Plaza Driver's License Office at 15400 E. 14th Pl., Aurora will be closed for the day. The Motor Vehicle Division will re-open to the public at all locations at 10 a.m., June 25.

The Board of County Commissioners approved temporarily shutting down motor vehicle services on Election Day at the request of Clerk and Recorder Matt Crane, in order to free up employees to assist with the election and free up parking at the Voter Service and Polling Centers. Clerk and Recorder employees will work as scheduled and may be called upon to help with election tasks, such as answering phones, directing voters and processing ballots.

The following Clerk and Recorder branches will be open as Voter Service and Polling Centers:

- **Littleton Main Office**, County Administration Building, 5334 S. Prince St., Littleton
- **Aurora Branch Office**, 490 S. Chambers Road, Aurora
- **Byers Branch Office**, 538 N. Highway 36, Byers
- **Centennial Branch Office**, Arapahoe County Lima Plaza, 6954 S. Lima St., Centennial

All other County offices will remain open as usual on Election Day. To renew your driver's license or motor vehicle registration online, please visit www.colorado.gov/revenue/dmv.

The Primary Election is a mail-ballot election. Voters who are affiliated with a major political party should have received a mail ballot, which can be mailed back with 70 cents postage or delivered to one of [20 drop-off locations](#) around the county. Citizens can visit any of the four Voter Service and Polling Centers to register to vote in-person, update their voter record, request or replace a ballot, or vote on an accessible voting machine.
