## **First Craft Brew Fest at 2014 Arapahoe County Fair**

*Local Brewers will bring their best brews to the Fair for judging and unlimited tasting.*

**Littleton, Colo.** — The Arapahoe County Fair is introducing a whole new line up of craft brews for fairgoers for just one night during the Fair July 24-27.

On July 25, more than 10 of the best local breweries in Denver metro will bring their most prized and unique brews to the Fair to be judged by fairgoers. Fairgoers also will get free tasting cups to sample as many brews as much as they'd like.

The 2014 Craft Brew Fest will be held in the Event Tent 4 -7:30 p.m. and tickets are just \$10 to get in. There also will be live music and free food for those participating in the tasting event.

Here is a list of some of the breweries that will be showing off their craft brews: The Brew on Broadway, Dry Dock Brewing Company, Two22 Brew, Three Freaks Brewing Co., Mu Brewery Inc., Dad and Dudes Breweria, Coda Brewing Company, Living the Dream Brewing Company, Blue Spruce Brewing Company, and Grand Lakes Brewing Co.

"The Fair is a great family affair, full of fun things to do for kids, and those who are kids at heart," said Arapahoe County Commissioner Rod Bockenfeld. "The Craft Brew Fest will be another great opportunity to bring people together."

CSU Extension Director, Tim Aston wanted to share the craft brew experience with fairgoers in Arapahoe County. "These brewers are some of the best in Colorado," said Aston. "They are excited to come to the Fair, and we are just as thrilled to have them join us this year."

Last year, more than 20,000 people attended the Fair, and this year the number is expected to grow.
