Helping people get health care, food, employment and other resources.

Littleton, Colo. – Arapahoe County is partnering with South Metro Health Alliance for a day of ‘Community Accessing Resources Together’, an event for people in need of health care, food assistance, employment and other support services in the community.

The event will be held at the Strasburg Community Church parking lot, 56155 Sunset Ave, Strasburg, 80136 1 p.m. to 5 p.m., Sept. 26.

Community Accessing Resources Together is a free event that will focus on providing the community with assistance and information on medical services, health coverage, food and other resources. Among the free services offered will be heart healthy screenings for adults, healthy smoothies for everyone, information on mental wellness, and employment assistance.

In addition, people will be offered free help and guidance with the Colorado health insurance exchange, Medicaid enrollment, finding a primary care physician, SNAP (formerly food stamps) application process, plus a variety of other community services.
