Voter Service and Polling Centers open 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. on Election Day

Visit any of 25 locations in Arapahoe County to request, replace a ballot or vote by machine

Littleton, CO – Colorado voters have the option to return their mail ballot to a drop-off location or visit a Voter Service and Polling Center to vote in-person by 7 p.m. on Election Day, Nov. 4. There are no assigned polling places. Find a map of statewide ballot drop-off and voting locations at www.mycoloradovote.com.

In Arapahoe County, there will be [25 Voter Service and Polling Centers](#) open 7 a.m.- 7 p.m. on Tuesday, where citizens may register to vote, request or replace a paper ballot, or vote on an accessible voting machine. Wait times, if any, at each location will be posted hourly at www.arapahoevotes.com to help voters plan their trip. You must be in line at a Voter Service and Polling Center by 7 p.m. in order to vote.

To avoid standing in line, citizens may deliver their voted mail ballot to any of [37 ballot drop-off locations](#) in Arapahoe County, including eight 24-hour boxes, by 7 p.m. on Election Day. It is too late to return your ballot by mail or parcel service.

“We encourage our voters to drop off their voted mail ballot before noon on Election Day,” said Clerk and Recorder Matt Crane. “Arapahoe County is being closely watched as a swing county in federal and local races. Although we are caught-up on processing ballots, we may not be able provide a full look at the highly anticipated results by 7 p.m. if we see a flood of mail ballots late in the day.”

Headed into Monday, Arapahoe County has seen approximately 46 percent turnout for the election, including 149,072 mail ballots and 2,310 citizens who voted in-person at a Voter Service and Polling Center.
