New brewers join the lineup for the 2015 Arapahoe County Fair Craft Brew Fest *Local Brewers to bring their best brews to the Fair for judging and unlimited tasting.*

Littleton, Colo. – Three new local brewing companies will join this year's lineup for the 2015 Arapahoe County Fair Craft Brew Fest, Friday night during the Fair July 23 – 26.

On July 24, Bristol Brewing Company of Colorado Springs, Elk Mountain Brewery of Parker and Hall Brewing Company of Parker will join returning brewers from last year's Craft Brew Fest including the winners: Living the Dream Brewing Company, Dry Dock Brewing Company, Coda Brewing Company and Blue Spruce Brewing Company, at the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds.

Returning breweries include The Brew on Broadway, Two22 Brew, Mu Brewery Incorporated and Grand Lake Brewing Company. More than 22 different brews will be featured and fairgoers will have the opportunity to enjoy unlimited tasting and vote for their top three favorite brews of the night.

"We first introduced the Craft Brew Fest to fairgoers at the County Fair last year and hundreds of people showed up to support our regional businessmen and women," said Arapahoe County Commissioner Rod Bockenfeld of District 3, which includes eastern Arapahoe County. "Supporting new local businesses is an important contributor to stimulating economic growth and we expect this year's Craft Brew Fest will bring more people together."

The 2015 Craft Brew Fest will be held in the Event Tent 4 – 9 p.m., July 24 and tickets are \$15. Tickets are sold separately from general Fair admission tickets and will include a tasting cup for sampling, food and live music.

Last year, more than 22,000 people attended the Arapahoe County Fair, and this year the number is expected to grow.

All fairgoers are welcome to visit the Event Tent where the Craft Brew Fest will be held but you must be 21 or older to participate in the tasting.
