Arapahoe County Treasurer to hold online tax lien sale beginning Nov. 5 *Citizens interested in participating encouraged to register now*

LITTLETON, CO --- The Arapahoe County Treasurer's Office will conduct an online tax lien sale beginning Nov. 5 at <https://arapahoe.coloradotaxsale.com>.

Bidding begins at 8 a.m., Nov. 5 and continues through Noon, Nov. 9. On the last day, the sale will close in batches with one batch closing each hour with the last batch closing at Noon.

Registration is required to participate in the sale. To register for the sale, research the available tax liens and place bidder deposits, visit <https://arapahoe.coloradotaxsale.com>.

Every year, the Treasurer's Office, which is responsible for collecting, investing and disbursing county funds, holds a tax lien sale where delinquent taxes, accrued interest and costs associated with the sale, are offered to prospective investors at a public auction. County taxpayers benefit when the County recovers the delinquent taxes.

Redemption interest is based on Colorado law. Certificates of Purchase sold at the 2015 Tax Lien Sale will carry an interest rate of 10 percent.
